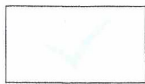


TRAIIDCRAFT

Pray for the life of the Stockport Circuit. May we feel the unity of God's spirit in the bonds of peace and love which connect us to one another

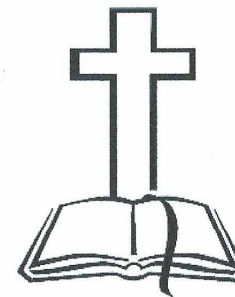

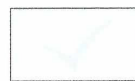
